

## YEARS F-2 DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES USER AGREEMENT

Access to digital technologies, including computers, school network, programs, the internet and online platforms for storing student work and collaboration are utilised as a tool for learning. While internet access is filtered at school by the Department of Education, and the school has strategies in place to teach children responsible browsing and net-etiquette, general internet browsing that your child undertakes from locations other than school is **not** monitored or filtered by the department. This agreement has been created to provide students with an understanding of the rules around using digital technologies.

## Student Agreement:

Throughout my time at Camelot Rise Primary School, I agree to use the digital technology equipment and programs from our school in a responsible manner for purposes stated by my teacher.

## At all times, I will:

- use digital technologies only as instructed by my teacher.
- keep my passwords to myself.
- not ask others for their passwords.
- follow school rules when using digital technologies.
- care for and look after all technologies.
- only access my own work (folders or files) on computers.
- always have my teacher's permission before communicating online.
- tell my teacher if I see anything online that makes me feel uncomfortable in any way.
- not use the internet to frighten, bully or annoy other people.
- only use social media apps, programs or accounts created by the school (eg. Seesaw, WebEx), as instructed by a teacher.
- follow the school's mobile phone policy.

I agree to comply with this digital technologies user agreement.

I understand that if I break the rules I will lose access to digital technologies at school.

I understand that all teachers will enforce the digital technologies agreement, not just my own.
